Hello all,

I have additional information about the upcoming Travel Oregon grant opportunities and a recommendation for you to take to your respective City Councils.

Firstly, the 0-\$20,000 Small Grants will open in July 2017. Any municipality can apply and can apply for more than one project. There is a 10% match requirement, so only \$2,000 would be needed for a \$20,000 request. These grants will be available six times per year until all funds are exhausted (and TO has plenty of money for the coming year).

Recommendation: Have each City budget \$4,000 for up to two small projects in the 2017-2018 fiscal year.

Secondly, the \$20,000 - \$100,000 Medium Grants will open in Spring 2018. The details about this program have not yet been released. There will be a 10% match requirement, so only \$10,000 would be needed for a \$100,000 request. Waldport and Yachats could go in together on one project or could each seek funding for individual projects. Note: because the applications will not be released until Spring 2018, the award of medium grants will likely not happen until the 2018-2019 fiscal year.

Recommendation: Have each City budget \$5,000 for a joint medium project in the 2017-2018 fiscal year.

Other notes;

- Mobile apps projects are ineligible for funding
- · Cannabis or tobacco tourism-related projects are ineligible for funding
