

CITY OF YACHATS
RESOLUTION NO. 2010-11-04

WHEREAS, City Council authorized the use of Visitor Amenities funds for construction of the North and South Gateways in the 2004-2005 Fiscal Budget and due to complications in securing an easement for the South Gateway is was not completed when the North Gateway was built; and

WHEREAS, when the easement was secured, the sign for the South Gateway was erected using a temporary method until the Job Corps could schedule the work; and

WHEREAS, \$20,945.65 remains from the original budget to complete the project, and the Job Corps has not been able to schedule the work the Public Works & Streets Commission recommended that City Council hire a contractor to complete the project;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Yachats resolves to accept the recommendation from the Public Works & Streets Commission and authorize the Public Works Director to hire a contractor(s) to complete the South Gateway sign project, cost not to exceed \$14,000.

This Resolution is memorializing an action taken by City Council at the November 8, 2010 meeting and was effective as of that date.
