Complaint—Suggestion for Regulation

To: Yachats City Council

My concern is not really an official complaint against a person or persons. It is more a suggestion on a regulation that should be part of the Vacation Rental rules for the city of Yachats.

We live on Ocean View Drive and observe many, many people walking their dogs along the drive. We have no objections to the dogs. Rather, we have an objection to their human friends. Although the majority of locals are very responsible in curbing their dogs at appropriate sites and picking up after them, this is not always the attitude of those occupying vacation rentals. Many neglect to pick up feces and many allow their animals to wet on the bench or on the lawn surrounding the bench. This is a family area where people eat their lunch and children play and it should be kept clean. This could potentially be a way to spread e coli throughout the community. The dogs also use neighborhood lawns at times.

Our suggestion is that part of the responsibility of having a vacation rental that rents to people with dogs should be the provision of an assigned location on the property for dogs to do their business. This information should also be posted in the rental along with other requirements. This should become part of the city code.

I would appreciate you considering this regulation to help with the health and safety of the community.

ORDINANCE NO. X

AMENDMENT TO CITY OF YACHATS MUNICIPAL CODE 5.08.030 ANIMALS AT LARGE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Yachats (City) has previously adopted ordinances establishing standards and provisions for protection of the health and welfare of its citizens and the environment of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to provide clarity and expand standards for keeping dogs within the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Yachats, Lincoln County, Oregon, that Yachats Municipal Code (YMC) 5.08, et seq., shall be amended in the following manner:

| Amend: | YMC | 5.08.030 | Animals | at | large. |

(A) No owner or person in charge of any animals shall permit the animal to run at large; including, but not limited to, dogs, chickens or other domestic fowl, horses, mules, cattle, goats and sheep.

Add: (B) All pets must be under control at all times. Methods of control

include a leash or demonstrated effective voice command. The person having control, custody or possession of a dog shall clean up after the dog by using a dog waste bag or other suitable method.

Add: (C) "It shall be unlawful for a person owning or keeping a dog to

allow the dog to deposit solid waste upon any property other than that of the person owning or keeping the dog. It shall, however, be a defense if the owner or keeper removes the solid

waste.
