

PROCLAIMING APRIL 2019 AS SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH IN YACHATS, OREGON

- **WHEREAS:** Sexual assault affects every Oregonian, whether as a victim or survivor, or as a family member, friend, partner, neighbor, employer or coworker; and
- **WHEREAS:** About one in four adult women in Oregon has been the victim of rape, and nearly one in five men in Oregon has experienced sexual violence in their lifetime; and
- **WHEREAS:** Compassionate, courageous and dedicated individuals, local organizations and other partners have provided services and support for victims and survivors and worked to prevent sexual violence for decades; and
- **WHEREAS:** Sexual violence is preventable, and all communities are strengthened when we promote healthy and safe attitudes, beliefs and behaviors, while also working to eliminate tolerance for violence; and
- **WHEREAS:** Every individual and community in Oregon has a role to play to help eliminate sexual violence by promoting social change.

NOW, THEREFORE, in recognition of the important work done by My Sisters' Place and Lincoln County Sexual Assault Task Force, the Yachats City Council hereby proclaims the month of April 2019 as **Sexual Assault Awareness Month** in Yachats, and urges all citizens to work with these invaluable community agencies to help alleviate this problem in Lincoln County.
