The Committee reviewed the Lincoln County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan document prepared by Larry Lewis. The Committee understands that approval is needed to match the actions taken by Lincoln County to meet FEMA requirements and does recommend approval. Please note that the 9 specific tasks included in the document are subject to revisions and updates within the next 12 months.

There are some recommended changes to the current document:

- Mitigation Action: Yachats #3 Remove the reference the Eugene Stormwater Management Manual.
- Mitigation Action: Yachats #7 There are concerns that naming Public Works as the Responsible Organization is not warranted. Ocean View Drive is a Lincoln County road and the plan developed by Yachats to accept ownership still has no agreement in place. There is a documented plan which should be referenced in Mitigation Action and wording changed to reflect the current status for implementing the plan.

Pending items for Emergency Planning include the following:

- Next Monday (October 12th) a pre-planning meeting is set with the Mayor Ron Brean, Council Member Barbara Frye, Fire Chief Petry, and LCSO Emergency Manager, Jenny Demaris to discuss Yachats participation in a statewide Cascadia exercise next June.
- Begin work of the Yachats Section on the Lincoln County Debris Management Plan which is pending adoption by the County Commissioner's this month.
- Continue work on updates to the Emergency Management Plan based on the last table top exercise.
