

Yachats Municipal Code

Section 5.08.165 Exterior lighting.

- A. Exterior lighting shall not be directed from the property of the owner onto private residential or commercial property, streets, parklands, or other public properties.
- B. Non-directional porch lights of one hundred (100) watts or less are not affected by this provision. For the purposes of this code section, a directional light is one that by means of a lens, reflector or other means directs the light in a desired direction.
- C. Where a public safety concern can be demonstrated, the City may grant exceptions.
- D. Adjacent commercial property owners may have shared lighting so long as the property of others is not affected.
