10 11	The decision became final on August 9, 2012	. The decision is a "land use
12	decision," as defined by ORS 197.015(10)(a)(A)(iii)). This decision is also a
13	"Measure 56 decision," in that it amends an ordinan	ce in a manner that limits or
14	prohibits land uses previously allowed in the affecte	d zone. The decision was
15	made without proper notice, which prejudiced Petiti	oners' substantial right to

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1 participate in the process.

2	Notice of the legislative hearing was sent along with city water bills. Some
3	city water users received the notice in the U.S. mail, along with their water bill.
4	Some city water users received the notice via email, if they had elected to receive
5	their water bills via email. Some owners of property affected by the legislative
6	amendment have undeveloped property, so they receive no water bill, and it
7	appears they received no notice of the legislative hearing.
8	In addition to the failure to provide notice to all required recipients, the
9	notice was inadequate in substance in that it lacked specific content required by
10	ORS 227.186. Petitioners' substantial rights have been prejudiced, and they are
11	adversely affected by the decision. This NITA is filed within 21 days from the
12	date that Petitioners first received actual notice of the challenged decision.
