**Title:** Recommendation from the Parks and Commons Commission - Signs for the Tobacco Free Zones

**Item:**

When City Council adopted the Voluntary Tobacco Free Zones in July the Parks and Commons Commission was directed to develop the signage plan, considering the Council's desire that the signs be welcoming and inviting rather than the standard regulatory signs seen elsewhere.

At their August 15, 2013 the Commission agreed to recommend to City Council that the attached sign be used.

**A. Tobacco-free Policy – Plan for Signage**

Niskanen said that City Council approved the recommendation from the Parks and Commons Commission to designate the City parks as Tobacco-free and referred the plan for signage to the Commission.

Niskanen provided a copy of the recommended sign. He also suggested that standard international symbols be used so that people from other countries will be able to understand the signs.

Commission discussed the size and color and agreed the sample would be submitted to Council for approval.

**Budget Impact:** It is not known at this time what the signs will cost, or the number of signs to be posted.
