**Title:** Street Name

<u>Item:</u> Although the County Addressing approved the name Chief Albert Drive for a road within the Creekside Development, that name was not on the plat map when recorded. In order to get it on the map now the City Council must take action.

The following steps must be taken:

- 1. Consensus is needed in writing from affected property owners. All affected property owners need to be contacted and have the opportunity to respond.
- 2. City Council approval (through resolution or other mechanism).
- 3. County approval If 100% consensus, Mike Moon in Addressing can approve. If not 100%, Moon has to take it to the County Commissioners.

All of the affected property owners were contacted and given until February 26, 2010 to respond. There are seven lots. At the time of the Public Works & Streets Commission meeting on March 2, 2010 there had been four responses. Four lots responded agreeing to the name change. Three lots did not respond.

The next step was for the Public Works & Streets Commission to make a recommendation to City Council. They have done so.

NOTE: On March 3, 2010 the City received a no response. Although past the deadline, I believe the reason it was late was because one of the property owners had died on February 27.
