Please consider that the small owner operated business is the heartbeat of this town and we as owner/operators are what makes this town work and adds in a positive way to the character and viability of our community.

It is our recommendation that the council simply enforce the current regulations and restrictions on the books and insist on compliance from each and every owner and commercial management company doing business within the town limits.

I understand that there are many homes represented by commercial interests that do not have licenses and do not follow the current rules. In fact many homes are represented by entities who do not have a local presence or any other vested interest in our town.

We would support strict local contact requirements and follow through as well as compliance to all current regulations.

Please do not kill the goose that laid the golden egg and allow us responsible owners to continue our business for the good of our town and tourist business.
